Lincoln Park Music Festival Rules and Events
Exhibitor/Vendor Agreement

1. These Rules and Regulations constitute an essential part of the Contract for exhibit space. The Lincoln Park Arts District reserves the right to render all decisions and interpretations and to establish further regulations as may be deemed necessary for the overall success and well being of the Event

2. The Exhibitor AGREES NOT to hold the Lincoln Park Arts District, the Promoters, the Sponsors, the Organizers, nor any agents, liable for any claim, loss or suit involving Exhibitor.

3. The Exhibitor agrees to set up at least one hour prior to the Event's opening, and to stay set up for the entire Event until its close; to leave with all unsold merchandise, boxes, debris, etc.; and to keep exhibit area clean and safe at all times. **Exhibitors must dispose of their trash in the designated area.**

4. All exhibits shall have cloth covering their tables to the ground otherwise use a suitable professional display. No boxes, extra merchandise or debris should be visible.

5. Distribution of advertising material and Exhibitor solicitation of all kinds shall be restricted to the Exhibitor's booth, unless agreed upon in writing prior to the Event.

6. Exhibitors wishing to insure goods must do so at their own expense. The Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District assumes no responsibility for nor guarantees the safety of the properties of the Exhibitor, its agents and their employees from theft, damage from fire, accident or any other cause whatsoever; and the Exhibitor expressly agrees to save and hold harmless Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District, its management, agents, employees, volunteers and sponsors from all and any liability resulting from injuries or damage to Exhibitors, their agents, employees, and specifically to attendees while within the Exhibitor's space.

7. Exhibitor shall be bound by all pertinent laws, codes and regulations of municipal and other authorities having jurisdiction over said Event, and shall fulfill all municipal, state and federal requirements in connection with all sales.

8. It is agreed that if the Exhibitor fails to comply in any respect with the terms of this Contract, the Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District shall have the right without notice to the Exhibitor to occupy, sell or offer for sale the exhibit space covered by this Contract without and rebate or allowance whatsoever to the Exhibitor. Said Exhibitor shall be liable for any deficiency, loss or damage suffered at the Event

by reasons herein stated, and without and ways releasing and Exhibitor from and liability whatsoever.

9. No Exhibitor shall arrange his exhibit as to obscure or interfere with nearby Exhibitors, in the sole opinion of the Event management. This includes, but is not limited to, the Exhibitor's sound system, generators, smoke, noise, audio-visual demonstrations, etc.

10. Exhibitor's exhibit or product may not extend beyond the limits of the Exhibitor's booth of 10' by 12' into any side space, or the sidewalk or street.

11. No open fires of any kind, no cooking in park without requisite permits from the City Health Department and a fire extinguisher.

12. The Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District reserves the right to decline, prohibit or remove any exhibit which is deemed out of keeping with the character of the Event; this reservation being all inclusive as to persons, things, products, printed material, conduct, smoke, noise, etc. items such as: "Silly String," exploding caps, noisemakers, and other "nuisance products" and any product not in compliance with federal anti-piracy laws are expressly forbidden to sell or possess and will be confiscated during the festival.

13. Exhibitor may display and sell only what he/she has listed on the application.

14. The Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District will not be liable for the fulfillment of this Contract as to the delivery of said exhibit space if any of the following causes should occur: public enemy, war of insurrections, local or regional civil disturbances, strikes, fire, the authority of the law, by reason of an act of God, inclement weather, or for any other cause beyond their control. The Event will take place rain or shine. **There will be no refunds in the event that the Event cannot be held.**

15. **There will be a 50% charge for Contracts cancelled more than 14 days prior to the Event. Cancellations are to be made only in writing and only by mail.**

16. **All refunds are at the joint discretion of the Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District.**

17. The Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District shall have full power in the endorsement and interpretation of all the rules and regulations contained herein, and the power to make amendments and further rules and regulations, as they consider necessary for the person or use part of such space.
